NAVIGATION INFORMATION

The initial stages of our voyage across the Atlantic will have taken us from the Southern coast of England and out into the Celtic Sea. Additionally during this afternoon we will be crossing over the Maxwell Fracture Zone, which is a large undersea mountain range forming part of the Mid Atlantic Ridge. Here, depths can shallow out to less than 1,000 metres before deepening again quickly to over 3,500 meters which is approximately 1.9 miles on the opposite side.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

STABILISERS

The devices which help the ship to be as steady as possible are the ship's stabilisers. These devices are incorporated in the construction of a ship to dampen down rolling in a seaway in order to provide a steadier and more comfortable passage through the sea. Gyro-operated stabilisers in large ships are retractable into compartments inside the hull below the waterline, and are thus stowed while the ship is in narrow waters, in port or when the sea conditions are calm.

STORAGE OF LUGGAGE IN SOUTHAMPTON

Guests who wish to store luggage after disembarking **QUEEN MARY 2** in New York prior to their return voyage in the future may do so with Luggage Concierge in New York. Please register at the Purser's Office. The cost of this service is \$65.00 per bag for up to 30 days and an additional \$30.00 per bag for the next 30 days. This will be charged to your on-board account. Bags must be collected in the Terminal ashore from the baggage hall and dropped off with the Luggage Concierge Representative after exiting Customs. Please note that New York requires 48 hour notice, therefore the deadline for the above service expires at 6.00pm on 20 August 2011.

EU TAX REFUNDS

Any non-EU guests with European Union tax refund documentation and receipts who were unable to get their tax refund processed prior to departing the EU, may do so by handing in the completed documentation at the Purser's Office prior to our arrival in New York. All completed documentation and receipts must be inside the sealed envelope provided when you made your purchase. These envelopes will be handed over to UK Customs when the ship returns to Southampton on 29 August.

DEPUTY CAPTAIN, ROBERT CAMBY

Robert was born in London, England and there started his school life. He was introduced to the sea from the moment he was born, having a father who had served in the Royal Navy and spending many family holidays crossing the English Channel on the ferries to France and Belgium visiting family. Robert and his family moved to Surrey when he was nine. Shortly after, he won a music scholarship for piano and violin to the prestigious public school, St Johns, in Leatherhead, Surrey. This was no surprise as his late paternal grandfather was a professional violinist and his maternal grandfather, the late Johnny Douglas, was the highly acclaimed film music composer of The Railway Children to name one, and also the primary music director of the RCA Living Strings series in the USA. Robert's first introduction to cruising was through his maternal grandfather, who took the family on SS Canberra on their first cruise when he was 14. Cruising became the annual family holiday. After finishing school at 18, he began his sea career at

South Shields Nautical College as a cadet with P&O Princess Cruises. His first ship was SS Canberra. After intensive college and sea training on ships across the P&O Princess Cruises fleet, he gained his masters ticket in December 2003. He has extensive worldwide navigational experience as he travelled in the rank of navigator for many years on P&O and Princess Ships including 18 months on the MV Royal Princess which continually circumnavigated the world. He took a 6 month break from deep sea in 2005 and worked as Chief Officer on Condor Ferries driving the fast Sea Cats out of Weymouth and Poole to the Channel Islands. He returned to the deep sea in November 2005 and was thrilled to be appointed as navigator on the prestigious Cunard Flagship **QUEEN MARY 2** where he has remained and worked his way up the ranks. He was appointed Deputy Captain in June 2008. When on leave, he enjoys many sports and follows cricket, rugby and motor racing. He still plays the piano and is closely associated with theatre world both in the West End and Broadway. He is an active member of the Honourable Company of Master Mariners, The Royal Society of St. George and The Lord's Taverners, crickets no. 1 charity. In November 2007 he was made a Freeman of the City of London. In October 2008, he was privileged to become a Chevalier of the Ordre des Coteaux de Champagne.
