NAVIGATION INFORMATION

Today we will pass across the Grand Banks of Newfoundland, where the water rapidly shallows from over 3,000 metres to less than 60 metres in parts. The Grand Banks form part of the continental shelf extending from Newfoundland and North America into the Atlantic. Known for both its abundance of marine life as well as infamous fog patches, the Grand Banks are a rich natural resource.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

ENSIGN

The country in which a ship is registered is indicated by a flag known as an ensign. Traditionally, this flag is flown from the gaff, which extends from the top of the foremast, just aft of the bridge, when at sea or the staff on the stern of a ship whilst alongside a quay. British vessels may fly one of three different ensigns, which consist of a union flag on one of three coloured backgrounds. The red ensign is flown by British registered merchant ships. The blue ensign is flown by British naval auxiliary vessels, such as those operated by the Royal Fleet Auxiliary as well as by a merchant vessel if the commanding officer has attained the rank of commander or above in the royal naval reserves. The white ensign is flown by all ships of the British Navy. When hoisting the ensign, a sailor must be very careful and ensure it is flown the right way up. An ensign flown upside-down traditionally indicated distress aboard a vessel, usually mutiny!

STORAGE OF LUGGAGE IN NEW YORK

Guests who wish to store luggage after disembarking **QUEEN MARY 2** in New York prior to their return voyage in the future may do so with Luggage Concierge in New York. Please register at the Purser's Office. The cost of this service is \$65.00 per bag for up to 30 days and an additional \$30.00 per bag for the next 30 days. This will be charged to your on-board account. Bags must be collected in the Terminal ashore from the baggage hall and dropped off with the Luggage Concierge Representative after exiting Customs. Please note that New York requires 48 hour notice, therefore the deadline for the above service expires at 6.00pm on 20 August 2011.

Please be advised that jogging and power walking on deck is not permitted before 8.00am or after 8.00pm as this causes disturbance to guests sleeping below. Thank you for your co-operation.

SMOKING AREAS

Please be advised that all public spaces, alleyways and inside or outside elevators are non smoking except in Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Outside, on the open decks, smoking is only permitted on the starboard side of the aft end of the ship on deck 8, under the canopy and on deck 7 Aft under the dock. PAUL O'LOUGHLIN, ENTERTAINMENT DIRECTOR

Paul was born in Dublin, Ireland and spent his childhood in Oxford, England, where his family settled. He started his career at sea in 1980 after a fortunate evening that changed his life: the Director of Entertainment for Fred Olsen Line offered him a contract on board the M.V. Blenheim after seeing him perform. Paul then became an Entertainments Officer for the Peninsular & Oriental Steam Navigation Company on board the legendary SS Canberra in 1981, and fell in love with life at sea. In 1982, he became an Assistant Cruise Director for Princess Cruises. He was quickly promoted to Cruise Director in 1986 at the age of 24. His life at sea has brought many unforgettable moments; he was Cruise Director on board the Pacific Princess for the July 7th 1987 celebration of the 150th

anniversary of P&O at Greenwich, England. Paul was presented to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness the Duke of Edinburgh. Paul was also honoured to sail with President George Bush and First Lady Barbara Bush. He treasures another special moment when he was introduced to Her Royal Highness, Diana, the Princess of Wales at the naming ceremony of the Royal Princess. He has hosted many celebrities and dignitaries as well as sharing a stage with Hollywood legends and entertainers including Ginger Rogers, Tony Bennett, Vic Damone, Artie Shaw, Red Buttons, Ben Vereen, Roberta Flack and Cleo Laine. He has interviewed John Cleese, James Michener, PD James, Baz Luhrmann, Jane Russell, Dr Ruth Westheimer, Jean Michel Cousteau, Edwina Currie, Ludovic Kennedy and Moira Shearer, Lloyd Bridges, Jonathan Humphrys, ITN's Michael Nicholson and many more. He has appeared on numerous radio and television programmes over the years. He co-starred as an entertainer in an episode of the American TV show "Loveboat - The Next Wave". His career has spanned nearly 30 years and he has sailed on 28 different ships, seven of them new builds. The Entertainment Director's day consists of around 12 hours of duties commencing recording live TV shows, meeting with the Executive Officers of the ship, contact with corporate office in Southampton, meeting with his own managers and staff of over 120 in the Entertainment department, socialising with guests as host with the Commodore at cocktail parties and generally supervising the overall entertainment programme. Paul is married to Deborah, a former P&O/Princess Senior Nursing Officer. They live with their Shar Pei dog Harry in a delightful old fishing town called Whitby on the North East coast of England. He has many interests which include theatre, sport, music, long walks over the North Yorkshire Moors and looking for his ball on numerous golf courses. One of the proudest moments of his career was his appointment to the magnificent **QUEEN MARY 2** and to become a part of the greatest and most famous shipping line in the world. 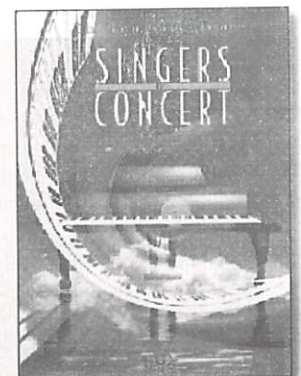
