### NAVIGATION INFORMATION

By this afternoon Queen Mary 2 will pass south of Cape Sable, Nova Scotia and proceed rapidly towards the Continental Shelf. We will then sail a Rhumb Line course to New York southeast of Nantucket Island and enter the westbound traffic lane leading to New York Harbour. By the early hours of tomorrow morning we will be entering the Sandy Hook Pilot boarding area, marking the traditional end of the Atlantic passage. A local harbour pilot will board at this position, assisting us through the Ambrose Channel and underneath the Verrazano Narrows Bridge, which our funnel will clear by approximately 4 metres

## US IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

On the morning of arrival at Brooklyn, US Customs and Border Protection will be inspecting ALL **QUEEN MARY 2** guests (Disembarking and In Transit), regardless of nationality. The inspection will be carried out in the Terminal Building. Guests are kindly requested to carefully follow the disembarkation instructions that will be delivered to your stateroom.

### DISSEMBARKING GUESTS

After you have finally disembarked **QUEEN MARY 2**, you will collect your luggage from the baggage hall and then proceed through this important Immigration Inspection and clear Customs.

### IN TRANSIT GUESTS

All In Transit guests are required to attend the Immigration and Customs Inspection. Please be advised that you will NOT be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have disembarked. However, if you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall where there is seating available. You will be advised once you are allowed to re-board **QUEEN MARY 2**. For your information there is no need to check-in again.

You will be required to present the following;

### PASSPORT

All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport.

### US CUSTOMS FORMS

All guests (or one per family with the same last name) are required to complete the Customs Declaration form prior to arrival in the USA.

### IMMIGRATION FORMS
